

MINUTES OF LICENSING SUB-COMMITTEE (GENERAL)

1. MOTION TO EXCLUDE THE PUBLIC UNDER SECTION 100(A)(4) OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1972

RESOLVED THAT- under Section 100(A) (4) of the Local Government Act 1972 the public be excluded from the meeting for the following items on the grounds that they involve the likely disclosure of information defined in paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 12A of the Act.

2. CONSIDERATION OF AN EXISTING DUAL DRIVER'S LICENCE

The Sub-Committee considered the private report of the Head of Environment and Public Realm (Part 2 - Agenda Item 1) concerning an existing Dual Driver's Licence.

The driver was present with their legal representative, Mr Schiller, who addressed the Sub-Committee.

Councillor Cade declared a non-pecuniary interest as defined by the Council's Code of Conduct for Councillors by virtue of being a Director of Rugby First Limited.

Due to technical issues it was not possible to view CCTV footage and there were other points that required further investigation, outcomes, or clarification. In consultation with Mr Schiller, it was agreed that in fairness to both parties, consideration of the item should be postponed allowing time for footage to be shared and when more detail would be available on the other points.
